LRSC Student Senate voiced their concern. In the past few years, many organizations on campus have sponsored activities to promote tobacco free living. "We do have students who smoke and use tobacco but the support by students for the campus to be tobacco free has been tremendous," said Student Senate advisor Randall Fixen.

The new policy, which goes into effect January 11, 2010, states that smoking and the use of chewing tobacco are prohibited anywhere in LRSC buildings and in LRSC property.
