Green Energy

There are many new green-collar job titles on O*Net, which is developed for the U.S. Department of Labor. The number of new green jobs is not surprising, given the federal government's active role in building a green economy. Even before the federal stimulus dollars kicked in, wind energy was big and growing. The American Wind Energy Association (AWEA) reports that the wind industry grew by 45 percent in 2007 alone. Civil engineers who work on various aspects of the wind farm now have their own job category: **wind farm engineers**. These engineers work on performance of turbines and the overall performance of the wind farm and also oversee aspects of construction and mechanical development. They usually have a B.S. in engineering with a focus in construction or civil or structural engineering. AWEA pegs the average salary at \$80,000. Solar thermal technicians can expect to start at around \$40,000 a year or \$20 an hour, according to Red Rocks Community College in Colorado.

CBYX Accepting Applications

The Congress-Bundestag Youth Exchange for Young Professionals (CBYX) is currently accepting applications from your students and recent graduates who are interested in living, studying, and interning in Germany on a full-year, funded fellowship. Between the ages of 18-24, does not require any prior German language knowledge! 75 participants are annually awarded the CBYX fellowship to spend a year studying and working in their career fields while completely immersed in German language and culture. The CBYX fellowship includes:

- * accommodations living with German hosts, in shared apartments, and in student dorms
- * transatlantic airfare and monthly food stipends
- * support throughout the program year by local program representatives

Eligibility:

- * between the ages of 18-24 at the start of the program in July 2010, high school diploma or equivalent
- * strong interest in German and international affairs, and a strong sense of American identity

Application deadline is December 1, 2009 for the program
