CBYX Accepting Applications

The Congress-Bundestag Youth Exchange for Young Professionals (CBYX) is currently accepting applications from your students and recent graduates who are interested in living, studying, and interning in Germany on a full-year, funded fellowship. Between the ages of 18-24, does not require any prior German language knowledge! 75 participants are annually awarded the CBYX fellowship to spend a year studying and working in their career fields while completely immersed in German language and culture.

- * Support throughout the program year by local program representatives

Eligibility:
