


IPEDS Graduation Rate

Graduation Rates is an annual component of IPEDS. The graduation rate is calculated by dividing the number of full-time, first-time, degree-seeking students who completed their program within 150 percent of normal time by the total number of students entering as full-time, first-time, degree-seeking students during the fall semester (cohort).

2019 Cohort Graduation Rate

The 2019 Cohort is the number of first-time, full-time students who began seeking a degree in the fall of 2019 and completed the degree by August 31, 2022.

LRSC's 2019 Cohort consists of 198 students, of which 89 graduated within 150% of normal time. This results in a graduation rate of 45%, which is a 5% decrease from the 2018 Cohort. Below is a five-year comparison of graduation rates for LRSC.




IPEDS Cohort Transfer Out Rate

Of the 198 students in the 2019 Cohort, 47 transferred to another institution for a transfer out rate of 24%. The institution most commonly transferred to was UND, with 20 of the 47 students transferring there.

NDUS Community College Comparison


Below is a six-year comparison of graduation rates between LRSC and NDUS community colleges.

IPEDS Graduation Rate for On-Campus Housing

Of the 198 students in the 2019 Cohort, 92 lived in the residence halls. Of those 92 students, 48 students graduated for a graduation rate of 52%.
