

## SAM Results

### *First-time-at-Institution, All students*

LRSC reported 229 students in this cohort. Of those 229 students, 141 graduated, 2 are still enrolled, 40 transferred with no degree from LRSC, and 46 did not earn a degree nor did they transfer (current status unknown).




