Starting Fall 2025, Lake Region State College will offer a Surgical Technology Certificate Program designed to prepare students for a critical role in the operating room. Through a combination of classroom instruction and hands-on clinical experience, students will gain the skills needed to assist surgical teams during procedures. Training will focus on sterile techniques, surgical equipment, patient preparation, and teamwork in high-pressure environments.

Surgical technologists are in strong demand across hospitals, surgical centers, and outpatient facilities. This one-year certificate provides a direct pathway into the healthcare field. The program offers a fast-paced, career-focused option for individuals who want to make a difference in patient care.
