Thank you for enrolling at Lake Region State College (**LRSC**). This information is for new and returning students.

Follow the instructions on how to claim North Dakota University System (**NDUS**) account, access LRSC email account, Campus Connection, and more. Please read NDUS DUO Multi-factor authentication information.

Student NDUS EMPLID: provided in an LRSC email or from your high school administrator

NDUS email: firstname.lastname@ndus.edu provided in email or from your high school administrator

NOTE: Common names might include a middle initial, name, or a digit.

(Use official LRSC email address to communicate with LRSC faculty and staff)

First step, Claim NDUS Account: (NOTE: all passwords are case sensitive)

Skip this step if you have previously claimed your NDUS Account and enrolled at LRSC or another NDUS campus. Do not attempt to claim NDUS Account again.

1. Claim My Account
2. Watch the short video and click on 'Claim your NDUS Account'
3. Fill in EMPLID and Birthdate (EMPLID is included in this email or from your school)
4. Complete the Acceptable Use Quiz.
5. Follow the on-screen instructions.

Second step, NDUS DUO Multi-factor authentication

This additional layer of security is to help decrease identity theft and reduce the amount of spam and phishing attempts being sent in email. If you do not want to use DUO on your phone to authenticate, the LRSC Bookstore does have security token key fobs that will generate a code to allow you to authenticate.

LRSC Email

Access to campus email requires dual authentication.

Sign into email using your:

User ID: firstname.lastname@ndus.edu **NOTE: this login requires the extension, @ndus.edu**

Password: same password as when you claimed your NDUS account

Textbook

www.lrsc.edu > Student Life > Resources > Bookstore & Royal Java > scroll down click on 'Current Students' choose 'Order or Print Book List.' Under the Textbooks drop-down menu, CLICK on *Order Textbooks* and search by Term, Course, Department, and Course-Section-Instructor.

Note: Some courses offer a cost-saving eBook called **Inclusive Access**. This is an online textbook which is automatically uploaded into your course. No action is required. Your student account will be accessed the fee for the material unless you "opt out." If you choose to "opt out" of Inclusive Access, textbooks will need to be purchased separately. Online Course and/or Face-to-Face course using Blackboard (Bb)

Access to Blackboard (Bb) use one of two paths: online.lrsc.edu or

Access to Campus Connection requires dual authentication.
