- Contributes to and assists in implementing a plan of care that reflects the patient's physical, psychological, social, educational, developmental, and rehabilitative needs based on the patient's age, ethnic origin, economic status, lifestyle, creed, or philosophical beliefs.
- Demonstrates competency and ability to carry out department-specific functions in accordance with the department's standards of care, policies, and procedures. Performs other duties as assigned to meet the needs of the department/organization.
- Contributes to the assessment of the health status of patients, including interactions with the patient's family members by collecting basic subjective and objective data from observations and interviews, including taking vital signs and reporting and recording appropriately.
- Identifies basic signs and symptoms of deviations from normal health status and provides basic information licensed nurses use to identify problems and needs.
- Reports the patient's self-report/symptoms of pain promptly according to standard operating procedure.
