2+2 Agreement Between

Lake Region State College	University of Mary

This Agreement is entered into between **Lake Region State College** (hereinafter sending institution), and **University of Mary** (hereinafter receiving institution). This Agreement and any amendments and supplements, shall be interpreted pursuant to the laws of the State of North Dakota.

The sending institution has established an Associate of Applied Science (hereinafter sending program), and the receiving institution has established a Bachelor's of Science in Criminal Justice (hereinafter receiving program), and will facilitate credit transfer and provide a smooth transition from one related program to another.

It is mutually agreed:

Admission and Graduation Requirements

- a) The receiving institution's admission and program admission requirements apply to both direct entry students and to students who transfer under this agreement.
- b) Students must fulfill the graduation requirements at both institutions.
- c) Students must complete the entire sending program and meet the receiving institution's admission requirements for the agreement to apply.

Transfer of Credits

The receiving institution will accept 61 credits from the sending program. Sixty-four credits (64) remain to be completed at the receiving program. Courses will transfer as described in the attached Program Articulation Table.

Implementation and Review

The Chief Academic Officers or designees of the parties to this agreement will implement the terms of this agreement, including identifying and incorporating any changes into subsequent agreements, assuring compliance with system policy, procedure and guidelines, and conducting a periodic review of this agreement.

The college and university shall work with students to resolve the transfer of courses should changes to either program occur while the agreement is in effect.

This Articulation Agreement will be reviewed by both parties beginning within six months of the end date.

When a student notifies the receiving institution of their intent to follow this agreement, the receiving institution will encode course waivers and substitutions.

Effective Date and Duration

This Articulation Agreement is effective on _____ (insert date) and shall remain in effect for three years unless terminated or amended by either party with 90 days prior written notice.
