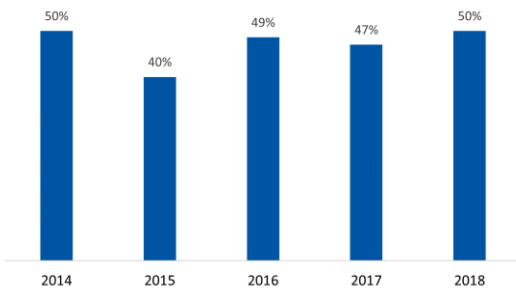
IPEDS Graduation Rate

Graduation Rates is an annual component of IPEDS. The graduation rate is calculated by dividing the number of full-time, first-time, degree-seeking students who completed their program within 150 percent of normal time by the total number of students entering as full-time, first-time, degree-seeking students during the fall semester (cohort).

2018 Cohort Graduation Rate

The 2018 Cohort is the number of first-time, full-time students who began seeking a degree in the fall of 2018 and completed the degree by August 31, 2021.

LRSC's 2018 Cohort consists of 197 students, of which 99 graduated within 150% of normal time. This results in a graduation rate of 50%, which is a 3% increase from the 2017 Cohort. Below is a five-year comparison of graduation rates for LRSC.

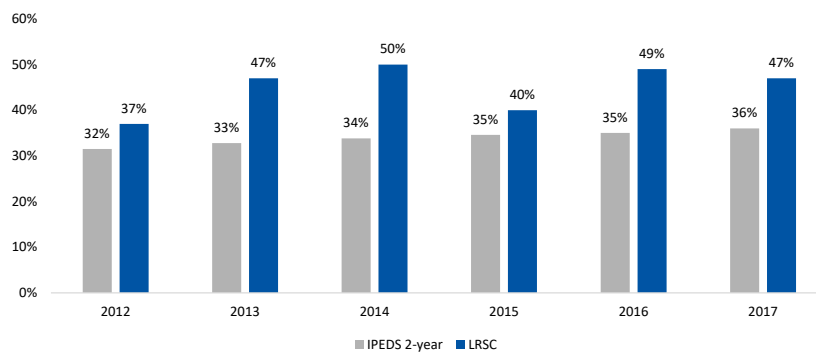


IPEDS Cohort Transfer Out Rate

Of the 197 students in the 2018 Cohort, 40 transferred to another institution for a transfer out rate of 20%. The institution most commonly transferred to was UND, with 16 of the 40 students transferring there. The most common discipline that students transferred into was Liberal Arts.

NDUS Community College Comparison

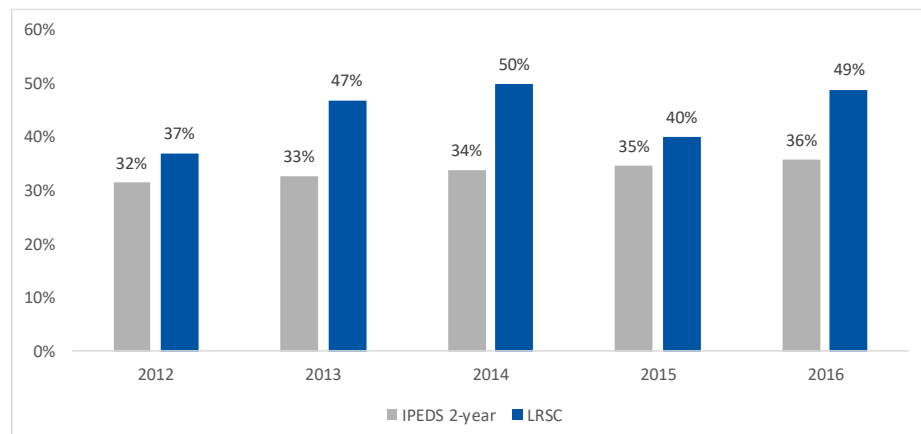
Below is a six-year comparison of graduation rates between LRSC and NDUS community colleges.

IPEDS Graduation Rate for On-Campus Housing

Of the 197 students in the 2018 Cohort, 104 lived in the residence halls. Of those 104 students, 67 students graduated for a graduation rate of 64%.
