1) CALL TO ORDER/REVIEW MINUTES

- a) Call to Order
 - i) The meeting was called to order at 9:34 a.m.
- b) Review of August 12, 2021 Minutes
 - i) The minutes of the previous meeting were reviewed and approved.

2) OLD BUSINESS

- a) Hofstad Ag Center Ribbon Cutting (President)
 - i) Invitations were sent out by US mail and email to community members.
 - ii) The official sign for the Ag center has been ordered
- b) **Shooting Sports Team Gun Storage** (President)
 - i) A gun safe for the Clay Target Team has been installed in the Physical Plant storage area at BTC. Keys have been assigned to the coaches and Athletic Director.

3) NEW BUSINESS

- a) POTP Staffing (Academic/Student Affairs)
 - i) VP Halvorson proposed hiring a couple months early and training prior to start of program to avoid training in Minot. VP Halvorson will work with HR Director Lillehaugen to get position authorization and list opening.
 - ii) Public Relations Director Wood met with POTP Faculty on marketing campaign for peace officer in Minot.
- b) LRSC Listening Session Plan/Agenda Input (President)
 - i) Starting this year in accordance with State Board of Higher Education policy, a comprehensive evaluation will be conducted every third year for all campus presidents. The comprehensive evaluations will be staggered so that each year, a third of the campus presidents will receive the deeper review. This year, the presidents at Minot State University, NDSU, and LRSC will be the first to participate in the comprehensive review. Two pieces of the comprehensive review consist of an online survey and on-campus listening sessions. With the online survey, a 17-question survey will be sent to campus students, faculty, staff, and the community. The Listening Sessions will take place on September 16, 2021. 9:00a -President's Cabinet-HH, 10:00a-Staff-HH, 11:00a-Faculty-HH, Noon-Community-CR, 1:00p-Students-HH. Joining us from the System office are Billy Jo Lorius and Jerry Rostad, Tim Mihalick is the SBHE representative.
- c) Signage Update (College Relations)
 - i) College Relations Director Wood discussed a large display that will be used to showcase all the Dual Credit schools we serve. It will go on the wall between the College Relations and Distance Ed Offices. Facilities wants to do some work on that wall prior, so install date has not been set but hoping toward end of 2021.

There will be new signs for the Snack Bar and other signage throughout the Student Union and Dining Room. Director Wood discussed other ideas regarding signage/recognition in the Hall of Fame area. Council also discussed a better way to display Hall of Fame and retirees' photos. President Darling would like a plan to be in place prior to removal of any photos. Other areas Director Wood proposed considering for and updated look included bell tower lighting and signage in the blue over the LRSC front entrance; a replacement of the mission statements above Dining Room doorway (replacing one that was taken down when area was painted); and new identifying signage for Trio/PowerSkills sign. The outdoor information/directional signs will be updated this fall as they are faded and in need of updating. Finally, a larger and lighted sign at the north entrance also is being researched. Director Wood will place all information in a spreadsheet to request cost approval and prioritization. To reclaim wall space for students she will form a group to decide what to do with the current displays.

d) **Update LRSC Committee list** (President)

i) Lloyd Halvorson stated we need more faculty participation on the Diversity committee. Council discussed and decided to replace Teresa Tande with Jenna Brooks and add Richard Olson, Oybek Turayev, and Jared Marshall. Delete the Facility scheduling Ad Hoc committee that is no longer meeting. The updated committee list is attached below.
