1) CALL TO ORDER/REVIEW MINUTES

- a) Call to Order
 - i) The meeting was called to order at 1:03 a.m.
- b) Review of July 10, 2023, minutes
 - i) The minutes of the previous meetings were reviewed and approved.

2) OLD BUSINESS

- a) NDUS Enterprise Risk Management 2023-2024 Cycle (President)
 - i) Director Lillehaugen will send the updates to include in the minutes when she has them entered.

3) NEW BUSINESS

- a) Website Directory/Department Listings (College Relations)
 - i) Council discussed a request to stop publishing direct phone numbers as part of the directory information on the LRSC website. The request is due to an abundance of spam calls disrupting the workday. There was some discussion on what the HLC requires in the publication of directory information to stay in compliance. The decision was made to include main departments on the main directory web page, The directory website will still hold links to faculty webpages and the college directory of phone lines on a downloadable pdf.
- b) Email Signature Updates (College Relations)
 - i) Director Wood has received requests to include photos in email signatures. She discussed opportunities to schedule meetings through a link in the email signatures. Options to keep signature lines as they are but also give faculty and staff an option to add his/her photo and/or a scheduling icon for appointments. Council approved of adding the options and suggested training student employees to help faculty and staff update their email signatures as needed.
- c) Committee Updates 23-24
 - i) Council reviewed the campus committee list and made updates. The final copy is attached below.
- d) Budget & End of Year Report Including Designated & Undesignated Reserves (Administrative Affairs)
 - i) VP Kitchens gave a preliminary summary of the FY23 budget. LRSC had many savings in the appropriated budget in FY23. Most of those savings were open positions that weren't filled. The original tuition revenue budget was more conservative than what LRSC realized. Because of that, VP Kitchens was able to move \$361,000 of the expenses that usually come out of local funds (large share of athletics & part of the wind turbine payment) to appropriated funds. That helped overcome the lost revenue of the wind turbine. The

- Foundation is able to cover the basketball scholarships for FY23 so that will enable the Thelin trust funds to stay healthier as LRSC takes on deferred maintenance projects in FY24 & FY25.
- ii) Designated reserves: Appropriated reserves will increase by approximately \$428,000 (keeping in mind that we had a \$746,000 drop in FY22). Reserves will go from 1.8 million to 2.2 million. Approximately \$750,000 needs to be undesignated and approximately \$1.5 million will be designated into broad categories.

e) Breakfast/Campus Update/In-service Agenda

i) Council discussed the schedule for the Welcome Back Breakfast. It has been changed from Wednesday to Friday this year.

f) FY23-24 Department Goals

i) President Darling reminded council that each of their departments annual goals are due August 30, 2023. The templates were emailed to each department on 7/26/23.

g) **Discussion**

- i) Student Service updates: Assistant VP Driessen explained their goal to expand LRSC's service radius to 90 miles since student counts are so low in the area high schools. He reported that they are at 70% of goal.
- ii) Final approval for Air Conditioning for POTP classroom came in at \$8,500. VP Kitchens suggested taking the faculty on a tour of updated/improved facilities on Friday 10:45-11:30.
