The North Dakota Stockmen's Foundation (NDSF) is offering several scholarships in 2022.

- The NDSF Junior Scholarship is available to college students who have obtained at least 48 college credits, among other criteria, and are enrolled in a beef-related major at an accredited North Dakota college or university. Value: \$500.
- The NDSF Legacy Scholarships are available to high school seniors, college freshmen, college sophomores or college juniors who have an interest in the beef cattle industry and are or will be studying any major at any college or university. Value: \$500.
- The NDSF Endowment Scholarship is available to high school seniors, college freshmen, college sophomores or college juniors who are or will be studying a beef-related major at any accredited North Dakota college or university. Value: \$500.
- The Jack and Vander Reich Memorial Endowment Scholarship is available to any high school senior who is planning to major in an agriculturally related discipline at any accredited college or university. Value: \$750.
- The Tokach Angus Ranch Memorial Scholarship is available to students who are or who will be studying an agriculturally related career at any accredited college or university. Preference will be given to students who have completed their bachelor's degree and who are pursuing a graduate education or professional school (i.e. veterinary or law school). Value: \$500.
- The Myron Wold Memorial Scholarships are available to students who are or who will be studying an agriculturally major at any accredited college or university. Value: \$1,000.

A student may apply for more than one scholarship if applicable, but separate applications must be submitted. For all scholarships, applicants must be a member of the North Dakota Stockmen's Association or the child of a member.
